### 3 Stage entry criteria:

- 1) A completed entry form
- 2) A portfolio of not more than 12 low resolution digital photographs, either a photo-essay or individual photos. (Please follow the instructions on our website carefully) You must include a caption for each image in the metadata with your name, contact details.
- 3) A detailed written proposal of your chosen assignment. It should be noted that this written section is considered extremely important. The judges will need to be impressed by your ability to produce a convincing assignment proposal as well as your photography skills.
