THE PROGRAMME

- Industrial Measurement and Control/Instruments Mechanics Work
- Automation Engineering
- **B.** In addition, candidates are mandatorily required to have **five (5) O-Level credits** or its equivalent obtained in **one (1) sitting** in the following subjects:
- i) Physics,
- ii) Mathematics
- iii) English Language
- iv) Further Mathematics, Technical Drawing or Chemistry
